UDCDA Housing Programs

The **University District Community Development Association (UDCDA)** Home Repair Program is available for critical home repairs through the City of Buffalo to assist homeowner's residing in the **University District**.

The program will help homeowners with home repairs such as roof replacement, windows doors, main sewer

& water lines, electrical, furnace, hot water tank & hazardous chimney.

In addition, funds are available up to \$5,000.00 to assist first time home buyers with closing cost/down payment on the purchase of a single family home in the City of Buffalo.

Program Eligibility:

- Household income guidelines
- Owner-occupant for at least one year from date of purchase
- Households with more than \$ 20,000.00 in financial assets will not be eligible
- If homeowner owns any other property they will not be eligible (vacant lots may be allowable)
- Households in arrears for Water, User fee, City or County taxes will not be eligible (unless on a current payment plan)
